Application Requirements

1. Eligible applicant must be non-Thai residing outside of Thailand.
2. Applicant must hold a high school diploma (Grade 12) or equivalent.
3. Applicants must submit the following test results obtained no more than 2 years prior to the application deadline.

3.1 ONE of the following English proficiency tests

- 1) IELTS (Academic) 6.0
- 2) TOEFL (iBT) 61
- 3) TU-GET (Thammasat University English Test) 500
- 4) Old SAT (Critical Reading) 350
- 5) New SAT (Evident-Based Reading and Writing) 350

3.2 HSK level 4 (for applicants to Chinese Studies Program)

4. Applicants from schools must show evidence that they are studying in Grade 12 or that they expect to graduate at Grade 12 level prior to 15 May 2018.

Application Procedures

1. Complete the application form which is available on www.pbic.tu.ac.th from 5 March-27 April 2018.
2. Photocopies of all required documents must be initialized and certified by the applicant.
3. Submit the application form and all required documents online.

Required Documents

1. A printed version of the completed application form
2. Copy of passport
3. Copy of high school diploma or its equivalent
4. Copy of official transcript of records
5. Copy of official test results of English and Chinese proficiency

Admission Criteria

Students are selected through the written examination and interview administered by PBIC.
