Announcement of Application for Bachelor's Degree in International Programs

Pridi Banomyong International College

Academic Year 2020 (Fast Track Round: International Students)

According to Thammasat University, Pridi Banomyong International College shall accept application for bachelor's degree for the academic year 2020, fast track round for international students, in the two international programs as follows

- (1) Bachelor of Arts in Chinese Studies (International Program)
- (2) Bachelor of Arts in Indian Studies (International Program)

Thammasat University is announcing the schedule of application, selection, and details of procedure under the following items.

1. Venue of Study

Pridi Banomyong International College, Thammasat University, Ta Prachan campus

2. Qualifications of Applicants

- 2.1 Applicants graduated from secondary level or equivalent.
- 2.2 Applicants must not be in physical and mental health conditions or in critical state that affect the study.
- 2.3 Applicants must not behave as a person of immoral character or conform any derogatory behaviors.
- 2.4 Applicants must be a person of good behaviors and certify to the university that the applicants will intend to study at full capacity and strictly follow the university regulations both the current and the future versions.
- 2.5 Applicants must have not been penalized for offense or any corrupted behavior in examination for admission of higher education level in the past three years.

3. Specific Qualifications of Applicants

3.1 Applicants must have ONE of the following English proficiency test results which is taken within 2 years prior to the application date. (Applicants, who obtain nationalities of the countries where English is an official language, are exempted for English proficiency test results.)

- (1) IELTS (Academic) with a minimum of 6.0
- (2) TOEFL (IBT) with a minimum of 61 or TOEFL (ITP, PBT) with a minimum of 500 or TOEFL (CBT) with a minimum of 173
- (3) TU-GET (PBT) with a minimum of 500 or TU-GET (CBT) with a minimum of 61
- (4) New SAT (Evidence – Based Reading and Writing) with a minimum of 400
- (5) GSAT (Reading, Writing, and Language) with a minimum of 400

3.2 Applicants who apply for Chinese Studies Program are required to submit the result of HSK Level 4 test with the score of 180 at the minimum. (The test results must be taken within 2 years prior to the application date)

4. Number of Admission

- 4.1 Chinese Studies Program 40 students
- 4.2 Indian Studies Program 35 students

5. Procedures and Criteria of Selection

5.1 Requirements

(1) Applicants must have an English proficiency test results as stated in item 3.1 (Applicants, who obtain nationalities of the countries where English is an official language, are exempted for English proficiency test results.)

(2) Applicants for Chinese Studies Program must have the result of HSK Level 4 test as stated in item 3.2

5.2 Criteria of Selection

(1) Applicants must have (a) test result(s) stated in item 5.1

(2) Interview examination is weighted 100% of the total score.

(3) Applicants must proceed the procedure indicated hereby with this announcement and present themselves taking admission examination on the date, time, and pattern arranged by the college. Otherwise, applicants will forfeit their right of entry into the program.

(4) The judgment of the PBIC Admission Committee is considered final.

6. Conditions of Application

6.1 Applicants must ensure and certify themselves as qualified applicants in accordance with the requirements and criteria indicated in this announcement. If the University can verify that an applicant is not qualified with any requirement or criteria, the applicant will forfeit the right of entry into the program. In addition, the admission fee is non – refundable in all circumstances.

10. Applied Assemble Foundation (Certified True Copy)

- 10.1 A copy of citizen ID card or a copy of passport
- 10.2 A copy of proof of completion for secondary – level education or equivalent
- 10.3 A copy of transcript for secondary – level education
- 10.4 A copy of English proficiency test results as stated in item 3.
- 10.5 Two – inch photograph (Full – face, without hat and sunglasses)

Applicants must present the original documents of items 10.1 – 10.4 to the College on the orientation day.

11. Conditions of Successful Candidates

11.1 Candidates must be passed and eligible to study in Thammasat University in accordance with the program.

11.2 Candidates must complete secondary level of education or equivalent. If candidates are failed to complete the required level of education, Thammasat University will not accept the candidate to study in the University.

If Thammasat University can verify later that an applicant is not qualified with any requirement or criteria indicated, the eligible status will be forfeited. In addition, the fee is non – refundable in all circumstances.

11.3 Candidates must not be a student of other universities or other higher – educational institutes except public universities that offer a degree with remote or online courses.

11.4 Candidates must not be in physical and mental health conditions or in critical state that affect the study.

11.5 Candidates must not behave as a person of immoral character or conform any derogatory behaviors.

11.6 If registered candidates are proved to be unqualified or failed to fulfill any of requirements, criteria or conditions as stated by using false documents, the University will cancel the registration in accordance with Thammasat University Regulations for Undergraduate Degrees.
