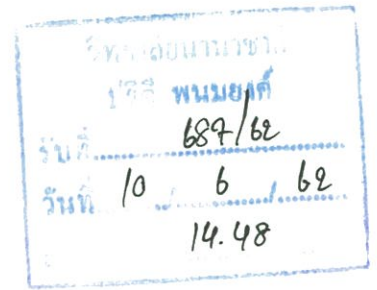

1. About Kyungnam University

Kyungnam University is the oldest and largest private university in the region, located in Changwon city in South Gyeongsang (Kyungnam) province in Southeastern South Korea. Kyungnam University has seven colleges (Liberal Arts, Health Sciences, Education, Economics and Commerce, Law and Politics, Engineering, and General Education). Its fifteen research institutions (including a world renowned Institute for Far Eastern Studies in Seoul) work to facilitate not only individual research but also cooperative partnership activities with academia, industry, and government. The university also has 113 sister universities in 28 different countries. The university specializes in globalization and localization under the university's motto of 'truth, freedom, and creation'.

* Hanma, a sweating horse is the symbol of Kyungnam University. According to the legend, Hanma has great endurance and can run 100 miles a day.

2. The Global Hanma Program

Global Hanma program is designed to provide Korean language, Korean studies and cultural classes for KU's sister universities' students. For three weeks, participants will learn, not only academic knowledge, but also cultural diversity through the classes and experiential activities.

KU's Korean buddy students will accompany international participants for cultural exchange between the students through all the programs.
