26 Jun 2020	Announcement of the successful candidates who have confirmed their intention to study at PBIC
7 - 20 July 2020	Academic English Course for all new students
To be announced	Team-building activities (The schedule is to be announced in advance later on)

Please note the following.

1. The transferred fees are non-refundable in all circumstances.
2. The payment of 25,000 Baht for successful candidates includes:
 - 15,000 baht for semester 1/2020 program fee
 - 10,000 baht for Academic English course as well as team-building activities.
3. All successful candidates must prepare one original and one copy each of the following documents to the PBIC orientation day (August 2020):
 - 1) Citizen ID card or passport
 - 2) Secondary school certificate or equivalent
 - 3) Transcript of records
 - 4) English proficiency test result (if any)
 - 5) Chinese proficiency test result (for successful candidates of Chinese Studies Program only)
4. Should candidates fail to fulfill any of the PBIC admission requirements, they will forfeit their right of entry into the program.
